

BYLAWS REVISIONS MEMBER DIRECT BALLOTING 2012 VOTE RESULTS!



This WILPF US member direct-voting balloting process on proposed amendments to our WILPF US bylaws has concluded. Ballot return envelopes were addressed to the Detroit, Michigan, branch on behalf of the section. Detroit branch has received all mailed ballots and tallied all those that were received and postmarked on or before the stated postmark deadline of October 12, 2012 - **a total of 240 ballots**.

WILPF MEMBERS BYLAWS REVISIONS BALLOT – VOTE RESULTS

Direct Election by Members of the Board President198 votes YES39 votes NO(3 abstained)

Staggered Elections of Board Members 218 votes YES 21 votes NO (1 abstained)

Addition to the Board of a Membership Development Chair and Committee 219 votes YES 20 votes NO (1 abstained)

Eight (8) ballot envelopes were received but postmarked after the 10/12/12 postmark deadline and were therefore not counted

According to the ballot instructions given to members about this voting process, these approved changes in the WILPF bylaws took effect upon completion of the tallying of the votes. The bylaws working group has indicated that the updated WILPF US bylaws reflecting these changes will be published to our website as soon as possible, but no later than by the end of October.
