Update on U.S. legislation supporting the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons:

Congresswoman Eleanor Holmes Norton introduced her bill HR-2850, the "Nuclear Weapons Abolition and Economic and Energy Conversion Act," as an amendment to the National Defense Authorization Act, which is in the midst of being voted on for 2023. Unfortunately, the amendment didn't pass out of the House Rules Committee, but it's another step in educating Congress members about the existence of
