

What the problem with Project 2025?

(October 2024)

This plan, written and disseminated by conservative groups including the Heritage Foundation, is created to direct the next Republican administration to further white Christian nationalist goals. This kind of policy framework is not new; there have been previous such blueprints for other conservative presidents. But this one is the most audacious.

As WILPF members should be aware, WILPF is a non-partisan organization: We do not advocate for one party or another (or even a third party). What we do is educate and advocate for policies that will lead to greater peace and justice initiatives here and abroad. The Project 2025 plan does not do that. It advocates for Christian nationalist positions, many of which are authoritarian, extremely partisan, and fascist.

Please be aware that this Plan is not just about the 2024 elections. Parts of this structure are already in place, dismantling democratic procedures. The interests that put together this plan will continue to push for it, at the national and state levels, and they will write another one for 2029.
